LONG-TERM CLOSURE OF SOUTH HARRINGTON STREET

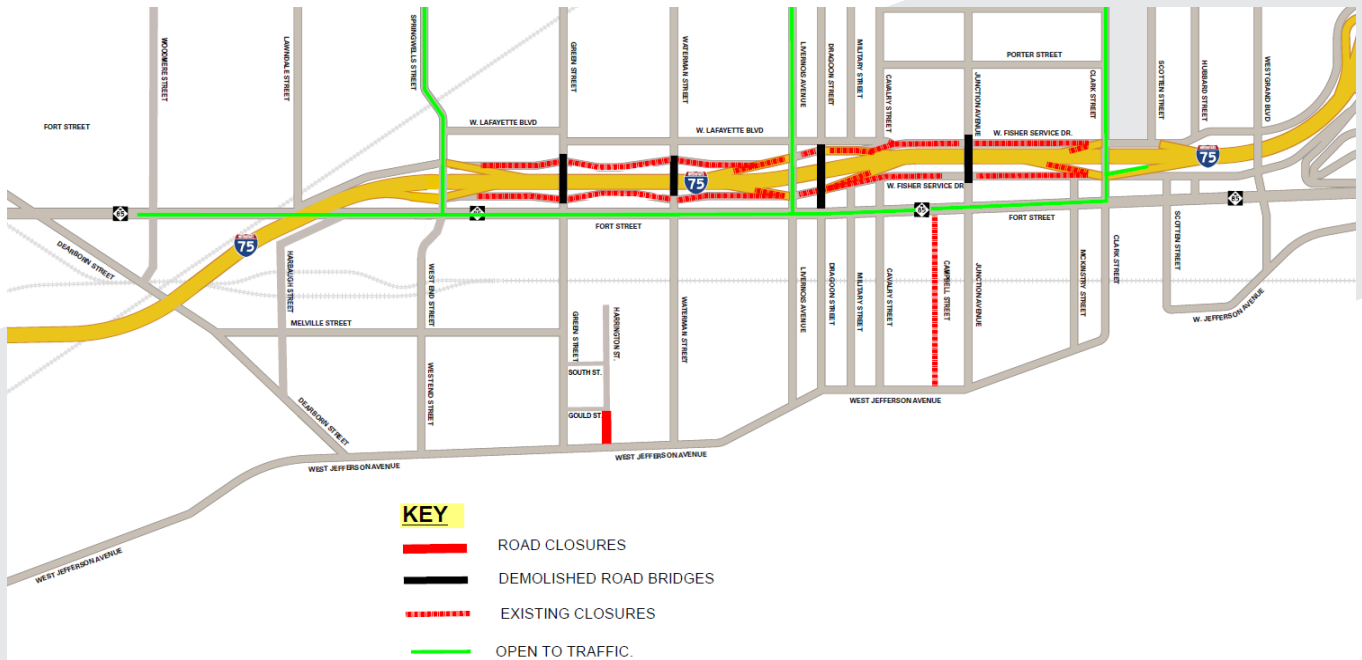
THE PROJECT

The Gordie Howe International Bridge project between Windsor, ON and Detroit, MI will help move goods and people more efficiently at this important trade gateway. Managed by Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority (WDBA) working in collaboration with the State of Michigan, the project is being delivered through a public private partnership (P3) which will see Bridging North America design, build, finance, operate and maintain the bridge.

On April 12, 2023, Bridging North America will close South Harrington Street over a long-term period between Jefferson Avenue and Gould Street to support the reconstruction of Green Street.

Local traffic traveling to Fort Street or Jefferson Avenue will be detoured to Green Street.
