Road Closure

Sandwich Street

- Southbound Sandwich Street between the Essex Terminal Railway (ETR) tracks and Chappell Avenue anticipated to close September 5, 2023, for 14 weeks. One lane of northbound traffic will remain in place. During this closure, businesses located on this section of Sandwich Street will be accessible via northbound Sandwich Street only.

Canadian Port of Entry (POE)

- Construction activities remain ongoing for interior and exterior components of the buildings and structures.
- This week, activities include drywall priming and glass fiber reinforced concrete, windowsill and roofing installation. Curtain wall installation and fencing activities have commenced and rebar installation and concrete placement continues, as well.

Canadian Bridge site

- Cap construction continued at anchor pier.
- Rebar installation ongoing for tower upper pylon construction.
- Installation of main span segment panels continued.
- Stay cable installation work continues.
- Approach and back span activities are ongoing.
