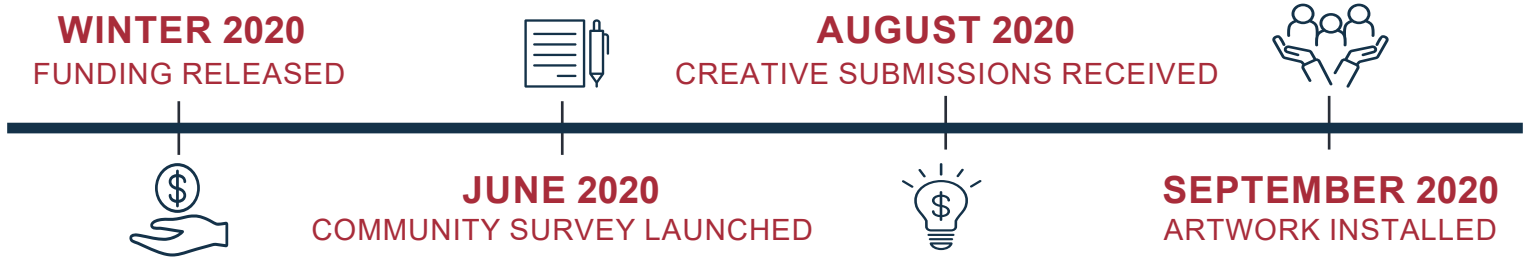


SANDWICH ART PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS
