



GORDIE HOWE INTERNATIONAL BRIDGE UPCOMING LONG-TERM ROAD CLOSURES

THE PROJECT

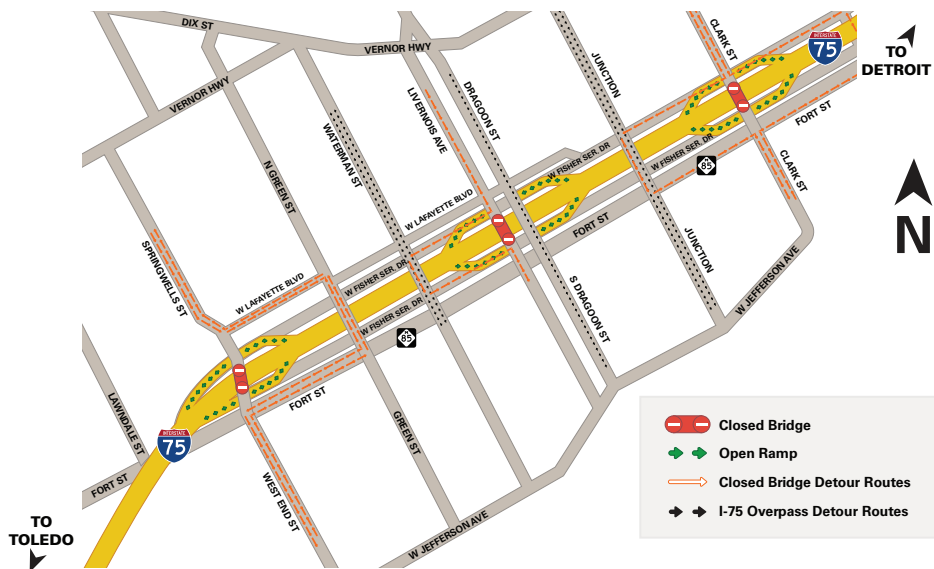
The Gordie Howe International Bridge project between Windsor, ON and Detroit, MI will help move goods and people more efficiently at this important trade gateway. Managed by Windsor-Detroit Bridge Authority (WDBA) working in collaboration with the State of Michigan, the project is being delivered through a public-private partnership (P3) which will see Bridging North America design, build, finance, operate and maintain the bridge.

I-75 ROAD BRIDGE CLOSURES BEGIN OCTOBER 21, 2019

Beginning on October 21, 2019, three I-75 road bridges will be closed in preparation for demolition and reconstruction:

- Springwells Street;
- Livernois Avenue; and
- Clark Street

Area of I-75 to be affected by closure of three bridges.



Over a single weekend this fall, the three bridges will be demolished, requiring closure of I-75 between Springwells Street east to Clark Street for a period of approximately 2-1/2 days. Detour signage will be in place to direct traffic to designated detour routes.

Once bridges at Springwells, Livernois and Clark are closed, adjacent bridges will remain open to allow traffic to cross I-75 in both directions. They are (west to east): Green Street, Waterman Street, Drogan Street, Junction Avenue, and West Grand Boulevard.
